# Summary

On 27 November 2025, industry leaders, policymakers, and innovators gathered at the Congress Center Hamburg for the Recharge Wind Power Summit 2025. Held in partnership with Wind Energy Hamburg, the event brought together experts from across the global wind sector to examine the key challenges and emerging opportunities in both onshore and offshore development.

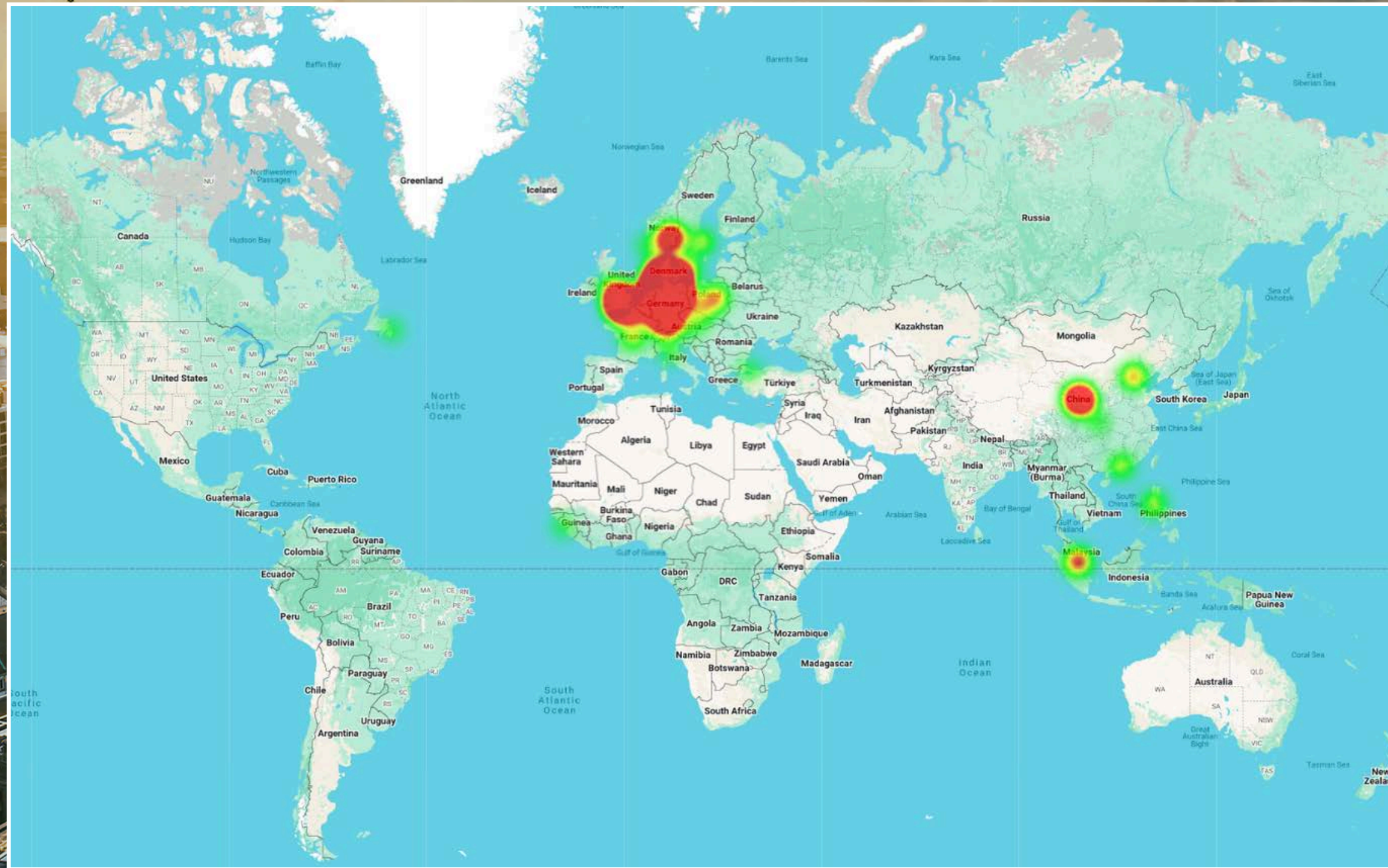


## Job titles of attendees by frequency

## MOU Signing: A Landmark Step for WindEnergy in Asia Pacific

A key highlight of the RECHARGE Wind Power Summit 2025 powered by WindEnergy Hamburg was the signing of a pioneering Memorandum of Understanding between Hamburg Messe und Congress, Recharge, Enterprise Singapore and the Singapore Tourism Board. Formalised at Hamburg City Hall on 27 November, the partnership secures WindEnergy's expansion into Asia Pacific and launches two major new events in Singapore beginning in 2026. This agreement strengthens global to regional collaboration at a crucial moment for APAC's wind sector, opening new avenues for growth, innovation and international participation.
