



## MOU Signing: A Landmark Step for WindEnergy in Asia Pacific

A key highlight of the RECHARGE Wind Power Summit 2025 powered by WindEnergy Hamburg was the signing of a pioneering Memorandum of Understanding between Hamburg Messe und Congress, Recharge, Enterprise Singapore and the Singapore Tourism Board. Formalised at Hamburg City Hall on 27 November, the partnership secures WindEnergy's expansion into Asia Pacific and launches two major new events in Singapore beginning in 2026. This agreement strengthens global to regional collaboration at a crucial moment for APAC's wind sector, opening new avenues for growth, innovation and international participation.
